

## THE **BIG** IDEA

### *The greatest gift you can give Jesus is you.*

#### **Monday:**

Many of us spend the month of December juggling different Christmas lists for the loved ones in our lives. Jesus' list is simple and has only one word: YOU. More than anything, Jesus wants you this Christmas. Have you given your life to Him?

Find the book of Romans and read chapter 10, verses 9 and 10. It's that simple—you believe in your heart and say it out loud that Jesus is your Savior. If you've never done that, take time to do it right now! If you have, let Jesus know how grateful you are for what He's done for you.

#### **Tuesday:**

The wise men gave the Christ child their worship. Check out Matthew 2:11. When's the last time you worshiped? I'm not talking singing, but worshipping? Pick a favorite hymn or song and spend some moments worshipping the King.

#### **Wednesday:**

The kings also chose to give Jesus their love. Read Mark 12:30—that's a lot of love to give! In which of those four areas is it easy for you to show Jesus love? Which is your hardest area? Spend some time loving on your Lord right now.

#### **Thursday:**

1 Corinthians 15:58 tells us to give ourselves fully to the work of the Lord. We can give to others when we give our time and talents to Jesus for Him to use in the church. New Year's is right around the corner, which means many of us will be making some resolutions. Pray and ask for God's guidance as you look for new ways to give your time and talents to His work.

#### **Friday:**

The wise men also gave treasures to the Christ child: gold, frankincense and myrrh. I doubt you have that lying around the house, but we can still give Jesus our treasures. Pray and ask Him to give you the faith to step out and give more of your treasures to Christ's work.

#### **Saturday:**

As you reflect on these gifts for the newborn babe, remember that He is also the mighty God, creator of the universe and Savior of humanity!
