

# THE **BIG** IDEA

*Help one person come to know Jesus.*

## **Monday:**

Jesus was pretty clear when He laid out our mission in Matthew 28:19-20. The task can seem overwhelming, but when you change your thinking and focus on just one person, it seems much more manageable. Write out that Scripture passage and read it this week as encouragement for our commitment for Each One Win One.

## **Tuesday:**

Evangelism or witnessing can be a scary thing for a lot of people. What do you find the most intimidating about sharing your faith with someone else?

Find encouragement in Jesus' promise (Acts 1:8), your own blessings (Psalm 126:6), and God's guarantee (1 John 4:4).

## **Wednesday:**

We often think of evangelism like door-to-door salesmen hawking God. But that's not what Jesus did. He built relationships with people. That's the best thing we can do. Can you think of someone who took time to build a relationship with you, someone who was Jesus in your life?

Is there anyone in your life now who could use a friend like Jesus? What can you do to be Jesus in their life?

## **Thursday:**

There's a poster in the sanctuary with a lot of signatures. Is yours one of them? Did you commit to try to win one person to Christ this year? If so, why? How did the Holy Spirit talk to you? If not, why not? Remember what Jesus said in John 15:16. No matter what you did on Sunday, what are you going to do about your choice?

## **Friday:**

Hopefully the Holy Spirit has started giving you a name or two of someone in your life that you can impact with Christ's love. Remember our motto: Hot Pursuit! That means continuing to reach out to people. They may not be receptive at first, but your constant presence in their life will make a difference. Above all, pursue in prayer!

Read Romans 1:16—I am not ashamed!
