

THE **BIG** IDEA

Build real relationships with others.

Monday:

As you start your week, take a minute and be amazed at what God is doing—that He, in all His power and glory and might—has recruited you and me to help save others. Let's not take this charge lightly! In this process of giving God all you have, make Colossians 3:23-24 your memory verse this week. Close by praying for the power of the Holy Spirit to give you all you need to do your all for Him.

Tuesday:

Reread 1 Peter 3:15. What great advice from the Rock—know your story. So take time right now to think through what God has done in your life. What was your life like before you met Jesus? How did you come to accept Him as your Savior? What's your life been like since?

Now, write it out! Remember, it's not a speech. It's just you telling your story to someone else. Put it someplace where you can read it and practice sharing it.

Wednesday:

God gives us opportunities in our daily lives to connect with the people around us. Who has God put in your life recently? They may be family members, coworkers or classmates, neighbors, old friends, friends of friends...let your mind run! Brainstorm ways you could make a God-connection with three of these people.

Thursday:

Yesterday you brainstormed. Today it's time to make the plan. Decide how you're going to connect with one person. Are you going to share about some awesome thing God taught you? Maybe you could invite them to the Chili Cook-Off or to your small group. Once you've determined your P.E.P, write it down. Don't feel like God has led you to someone yet? Pray!

Friday:

Now that you know *what* you're going to do, it's time to figure out *when* you'll do that. Set a target date for action and add that to your plan.

Saturday:

Pray. We will need the power of the Spirit for all of this, so continue to seek His infilling.
